

## Terms of Reference for the Airport Community Consultative Committee (ACCC)

### ***Committee Membership:***

The Committee membership will include representatives from the following.

- Community Associations who fall within the 25 NEF or greater contour according to the Airport Vicinity Protection Area (AVPA)
- City of Calgary, City of Airdrie, Town of Chestermere and County of Rockyview
- Airport user representation: Members from the major airlines and the general aviation sector
- Transport Canada: Members with expertise in Air Navigational Requirements and Safety
- NavCanada
- The Calgary Airport Authority: Members with expertise in airport operations and development
- National Airlines Council of Canada (NACC)

In an attempt to maintain an effective committee membership, each community will limit their representation to one member with a provision for an alternate should the member not be available to attend. For communities outside of the 25 NEF contours members appointed from those community associations may attend by request to the Airport Authority. The committee is chaired by the Airport Authority.

### ***Committee Objectives:***

- To provide a forum for dialogue and improved understanding between stakeholders and communities related to operations and development at the Calgary International Airport.

### ***Meetings:***

Meetings will be held twice annually and more frequently if necessary as required. ACCC meetings will take place in late April and late October unless specified by the chair for other dates.
