AGENDA REVIEW

Natalie Tomczak, YYC

YYC Executive Leadership Update:

- Provided a YYC Executive Leadership Update.
- YYC welcomed our new President & CEO, Chris Dinsdale in August.
- We also welcomed Kristan Jewell, YYC's new Vice President of Talent, Organization & Chief People Officer.
- Furthermore, there were two executive promotions at YYC: Chris Miles was promoted to the position of Chief Operating Officer, and Megan Gupton was promoted to Chief Information Officer.

YYC Operational Update:

• July saw YYC break numerous passenger records.



• The overall trend is indicating YYC has had a strong recovery post COVID with steady operations and increasing activity.

West Runway Update:

- Full project update by the Infrastructure team.
- Discussed how aircraft operations would likely be impacted including which communities might experience more noise during the construction season.
- Further updates will be given in the new year once closer to construction.

NAV Canada:

- NAV Canada provided an update on Jet Turns and noise concerns.
- Discussion was had amongst the group about consultation regarding the RNP changes, nighttime aircraft movements, as well as overall community noise impacts. NAV Canada will gather certain requested pieces of information and report back at the Q4 meeting.

Environment Update:

- Overall aircraft noise was discussed. Harris provided some contextual updates on regulatory discussions and how YYC is monitoring any changes.
- Group discussion was had about any potential opportunities to look into distributed operations once the west runway work is beginning.
- Update on stormwater odour was given. The dry summer resulted in increased odour, but with winter approaching this should alleviate any odour.
- Update on the zero-waste and net-zero strategy that Environment is managing.

STARS

- STARS representative gave a full presentation covering the history of STARS, how they operate, what they do and their funding model.
- See presentation for latest Q3 updates.

Group Discussion

- The group briefly discussed possible guest speakers they would like to hear from. Overall, the committee is open to suggestions.
- After the next ACCC meeting we might look to moving to a hybrid model for meetings giving members the option to come into the airport. No decision was made yet, but YYC is open for ideas on changing the meeting format.
