PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to define the parameters around consuming cannabis on Calgary Airport property. This policy works in conjunction with the Smoke Free Building policy.

POLICY STATEMENT(S):

The Calgary Airport Authority has implemented the City of Calgary Cannabis Consumption Bylaw. This bylaw states:

- A person must not smoke, vape or consume cannabis in any public place.
- An individual holding a medical marijuana license is permitted to consume cannabis in a designated smoking area on the public side of the airport only.

SCOPE:

This policy applies to all Calgary International Airport guests, tenants, contactors and Authority employees.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Airport Community is responsible to ensure their employees and guests adhere to this policy. The Bylaw is enforced by the Calgary Police Service (CPS) when reported or through the routine patrols.

- If a person is found consuming Cannabis outside of a designated smoking area and is in possession of a medical document will be asked to move to a designated area
- People without a valid prescription or card maybe issued a violation ticket
