

PROCEDURE FOR TEMPORARY HYDRANT USE

To prevent damage, the following procedures are required for non-emergency use of fire hydrants:

1. Obtain written authorization for use of hydrant from the Calgary Airport Authority, Mechanical Coordinator 403 735 7533
2. Use approved adaptor and valve on outlet of hydrant – do not use hydrant valve for routine opening and closing. Open hydrant fully after installing approved adaptor and valve.
3. Proper City of Calgary approved back flow preventer or air gap fill connection and City of Calgary approved water meter are required.
4. Notify Calgary Airport Authority Mechanical Coordinator upon completion of use of hydrant.
5. User of hydrant may be charged with costs involved in back-to-service operational check, repairs required, hydrant drainage and winterization if required.
